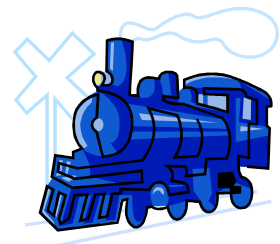

Sandringham Hotel

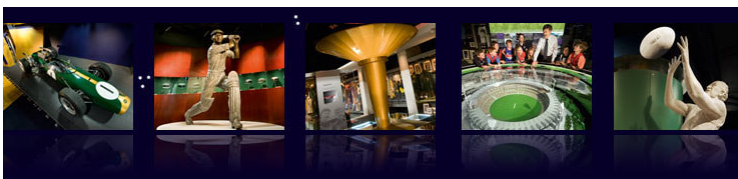
